Application

Properties

SYNTEVEN 432 is a cold-curing resin, even at very low temperatures. After addition of benzoyl peroxide (BPO) it yields a middle hard polymer. Fillers based on SYNTEVEN 432 cure fully both applied in thick and thin coats and they are particularly suitable for the applications where good adhesion, rapid drying and short dry sanding time are required. Combinations of talc, dolomite/calcite and powdered barytes with low iron content are suitable as extenders, with talc as the main component because it improves the adhesion to the substrate. The more spherical extenders such as dolomite, chalk and barytes ensure dense packing.
